Madison, Alabama (June 17, 2025) — Mazda Toyota Manufacturing (MTM) announced grants totaling \$168,000 given to 24 organizations that participated in the 2025 MTM Spring Grant Fund. This is the sixth round of grant funding distributed by MTM since 2022. Nonprofit organizations who apply are down selected through the grant fund process; finalists participate in a "MTM Pitch Day," where they have five minutes to pitch their organization's program to the MTM grant committee. Every finalist receives a grant of \$1,000, with larger awards going to those who are selected by the committee.

"Our team enjoys the opportunity to interface with our community and give back in this way," said MTM Vice President of Administration, Rhonda Gilyard. "We want to impact not just the organizations that we give to, but our North Alabama community as a whole."

Alongside this exciting announcement, MTM was notified that they would be honored as the 2025 Community Foundation Philanthropy Award recipient at this year's 16th Annual Summit on Philanthropy, taking place on October 30th at the Von Braun Center's Saturn Ballroom. This event serves to celebrate and inspire local generosity, as well as recognize those who exemplify its spirit.
